




Communion Reflection... Violin notes hung over the street, sweet and silken. This was no ordinary street musician! Caught off guard by the unexpected beauty, Steve Lopez, a columnist for the Los Angeles Times, followed his ear to Nathaniel Ayers, a homeless man performing a skid row concert using a heavily worn instrument with only two strings. The story of Lopez and Ayers, a Julliard-trained violinist with schizophrenia, is well documents in Lopez's book The Soloist and in the movie by the same title. The story begs an important question: If we believe all people are created in God's image, why are we amazed when a homeless person has remarkable talent? Advent calls us to expect the unexpected. Our Messiah comes not in kingly robes or priestly privilege, but as the son of a poor peasant girl, born among animals. It is so radical it's ridiculous. Why, then, are we surprised to find rich gifts in the world's gutters? Isn't that where we should begin our search for the sacred?



The Third Sunday of Advent is specially marked as an occasion for joy. Amid our Advent preparations, we might be feeling stressed at the work that still never seems to

end. We may feel frustrated by circumstances we didn't anticipate. We might especially feel disappointment in ourselves about the resolutions we made for this Advent to improve our spiritual lives that have gone unfulfilled. While Advent may be more than half over, there is still time to allow Christ's grace to finish what we started. The experience of joy is a sure sign that God is with us and a sure help as we work toward readying ourselves for Christ's coming. Don't be discouraged. Rejoice today and move forward. Lord, thank you for the presence of joy in my life. Give me the presence of mind to be thankful for all the gifts you have given me and the fullness of heart to enjoy the rest of Advent.



Time ticks by. That's what time does. Want proof? Look at our candle. It's half its original size! And now it's Pink, too—a sign of Joy on this Third Sunday in Advent. This Sunday is officially called "Gaudete Sunday." Gaudete means rejoice. And I suppose being halfway through Advent—halfway to Christmas—is reason enough to rejoice. But there's more to it than simply making a benchmark. Not only does this Sunday have an official name, but this candle has a name too. It's called "The Shepherds'

Candle' and you know what that means...it means we're getting closer to Bethlehem...closer to the joy we'll meet there. We're inching closer toward our Saviour! Rejoice!
