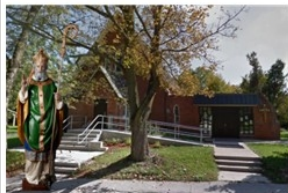

Of course, we have to take responsibility for ourselves and those in our care. But when it comes to the One who is both the source of our being and the final end of our existence, why won't we just give ourselves over to Him and let Him love us? Lord, speak a word in the centre of my being. Quiet my heart and let me dwell in the warmth of your love.
