

Stewardship Reflection The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

1st Reading:

Revelation 11.19a; 12.1-6a, 10ab **2nd Reading**: 1 Corinthians 15.20-26 **Gospel**: Luke 1.39-56

Mary, The First Disciple

Today's gospel from St. Luke depicts Mary as the very first Missionary Disciple! She travelled to her cousin's house "in haste" and literally takes Jesus to Elizabeth. Elizabeth's response is one of pure joy, and Mary is overcome by her own humility. She understands the greatness of the task set before her. She understands that her blessedness is not for her own glory, but for that of God the Father.

How does this compare to our own discipleship? Let us look to our Blessed Mother as the perfect example! Do we carry Jesus to others with the same eagerness? Do we recognize the many ways God has blessed and prepared us for the task? Do we see our discipleship as a way to glorify God in Heaven? Today, as we celebrate Mary's assumption into heaven, let's pray that God will give us the grace, confidence, and endurance to carry out our discipleship as she did!

Questions to assist your encounter with the Lord

- Mary set out in haste to visit her cousin. Is there anything the Lord has been inviting you to that you've put off or delayed?
 Take courage, respond to the Lord and set out.
- Mary expresses great gratitude to the Lord for all that He has done in her life. Take a few minutes to turn to Him with gratitude. How has He blessed you? What can you tell Him thank you for? In Discipleship we respond, fiat , to his challenging yet loving invitation. St. John Paul II wrote " ...Mary as Mother became the first 'disciple' of her Son, the first to whom he seemed to say: 'Follow me...'"




Our Lady is now in Heaven with Jesus, waiting in happiness for us to come and join her in loving and praising God forever.
