

An Attitude of Gratitude


"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice." These are the beautiful words we hear from St. Paul on this Gaudete Sunday. This Third Sunday of Advent is a time for joy in the midst of the waiting and preparation for Christmas. It is a reminder for us that despite the crosses and difficulties of our lives, the joy of Jesus' birth should always shine brightly.

One way in which we can cultivate a spirit of joy is through an intentional "attitude of gratitude." Former U.S. president, Theodore Roosevelt, once said that "comparison is the thief of joy." When we compare our lives, possessions, gifts and attributes with those of others, we inherently become ungrateful for the blessings God has placed in our lives. Perhaps one tangible way we can express our gratitude is to offer our time and talents to others this Christmas. As stewards, let us constantly strive to be grateful for our blessings and then seek to share them generously with others.

When the peace of Christ rules in our hearts, thankfulness overflows. Even in the darkest of times, we can praise God for His love, His sovereignty. - Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him, bless his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations. - *Psalm 100:4-5*

God sent Saint John the Baptist to prepare the people for the coming of Jesus. What did he say when some of the people thought that he might be the saviour? Look in the mirror to find out!


