Our Lady of Mt. Carmel—Feast Day July 16

According to the traditions of the Carmelite order, on July 16, 1251, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite. During the vision, she revealed to him the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, popularly known as the "Brown Scapular." A century and a quarter later, the Carmelite order began to celebrate on this date the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. The feast celebrates the devotion that the Blessed Virgin Mary has to those who are devoted to her, and who signal that devotion

by wearing the Brown Scapular. According to tradition, those who wear the scapular faithfully and remain devoted to the Blessed Virgin until death will be granted the grace of final perseverance and delivered from Purgatory.

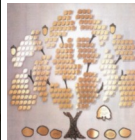
Prayer to Our Lady of Mount Carmel

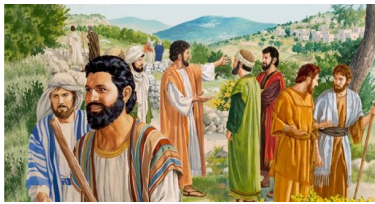

Stewardship Reflection
15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading:
Amos 7.12-15

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

What is one way you can be a “fisher of men” this week?

Jesus sent the Twelve two by two in an effort to evangelize others. It is a simple plan, if you think about it ... a matter of multiplication and exponents! If the Twelve do their job well, then they send others and soon 12 becomes 24 and then 48 and so on! This is still the best plan for evangelizing others! You, as a missionary disciple, have been summoned and equipped by Jesus, and you have been sent to evangelize others. You do so in your words and your actions. You do so at home, at work, at the ball fields, at Mass, and even in the car! Are you conducting yourself in a way that will cause others to want to join you in the mission? Are you seeking opportunities throughout the day to share the Gospel in some way? The math only works if YOU work!

Jesus gave the disciples the dignity of representing Him as they were out on their missions. They became “fishers of men” (Mark 1:17) by sharing in His work: preaching repentance, teaching, driving out demons, and healing the people. How is Jesus sending you to help Him continue His mission today, in 2021? What specific role do you have as His missionary disciple?

Trust and faith are the keys to learning how to abandon yourself to God's providence. What are some practical ways that you can learn to depend on God and not on your own resources or strengths? (Some ideas to get you started: consider bringing your needs and worries to God in daily prayer. Also, ask Him to guide you in your daily activities, large and small, praying that you please Him and accomplish the mission He has given you for that day.)

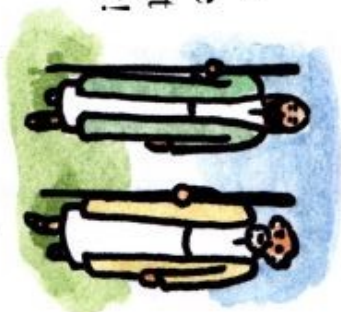
God wants you to teach people
