Our Lady of Mt. Carmel–Feast Day July 16 According to the traditions of the Carmelite order, on July 16, 1251, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite. During the vision, she revealed to him the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, popularly known as the "Brown Scapular." A century and a quarter later, the Carmelite order began to celebrate on this date the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. The feast celebrates the devotion that the Blessed Virgin Mary has to those who are devoted to her, and who signal that devotion

by wearing the Brown Scapular. According to tradition, those who wear the scapular faithfully and remain devoted to the Blessed Virgin until death will be granted the grace of final perseverance and delivered from Purgatory.

A partial Indulgence is granted to the faithful who recite this litany.
