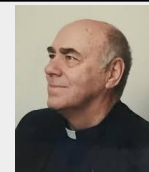

In your prayers & Mass intentions, please remember the soul of the late **Rev. Fr. Edward Jackman**, who passed away on Friday, June 18th. Our deepest condolences to the Jackman family for their loss.



Brief Biography: Fr. Edward attended Victoria University in the University of Toronto as had been the family tradition and graduated with a BA in philosophy in 1962. His love of his alma mater never waned and throughout his life he was a generous benefactor of its programs and scholars. After his graduation he underwent a time of great spiritual discernment, which was marked by his conversion to Roman Catholicism. This set him on a lifelong journey in service to the church, its history, and its many charitable works. In 1971, he was ordained into the Catholic priesthood and became a member of the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans). Fr. Edward was a generous benefactor to several religious and academic institutions through the Jackman Foundation which included St. Patrick's Church. He was interested in preserving the history of St. Margaret Queen of Scotland Church, Tuam located on the Second Line, Schomberg and was a major benefactor in the building of the new St. Mary's Church. He also supported St. Patrick's Parish in the celebration of the Holy Mass in past years.

A booklet entitled, St. Patrick's Parish Centennial 1876 -1976 was produced by a committee who published this parish record working under the leadership of Father Edward, O.P. who was the archivist of the Archdiocese of Toronto. Father Edward diligently undertook the challenge of researching the historical evolution of St. Patrick's Parish and an enthusiastic number of parishioners added their recollections and contributions to produce a booklet. 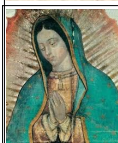

Stewardship Reflection
14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading:

Ezekiel 2:3-5

2nd Reading:

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Gospel: Mark 6:1-6

Persevere in Discipleship

Spend some time today with these lines from Ezekiel: “Hard of face and obstinate of heart are they to whom I am sending you. But you shall say to them: Thus says the LORD GOD! And whether they heed or resist — for they are a rebellious house — they shall know that a prophet has been among them.” Try placing yourself in this passage as the prophet who has been sent to convert hardened hearts.

As missionary disciples, we should resemble this prophet. God has chosen and sent us; He intends to use us as instruments in His divine will and He warns that it won't be an easy task. Like Jesus in today's gospel, we won't always be well-received, but we are called to persevere. It is easy to discuss our faith with like-minded people, but we are called to share it with those who are more resistant. And remember – you are cooperating with God's plan, but you are not the Author of the plan!

Plant the seed, and trust that wherever you go, regardless of how you were treated, “they shall know that a prophet has been among them.” Pray with this. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with the confidence to engage in the difficult work!

Therefore I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities for the sake of Christ; for whenever I am weak, then I am strong. - **2 Corinthians 12:10**

Stewards do four things... Receive God's gifts gratefully,
Nurture God's gifts responsibly, Share God's gifts justly and charitably, Return those gifts to God abundantly.

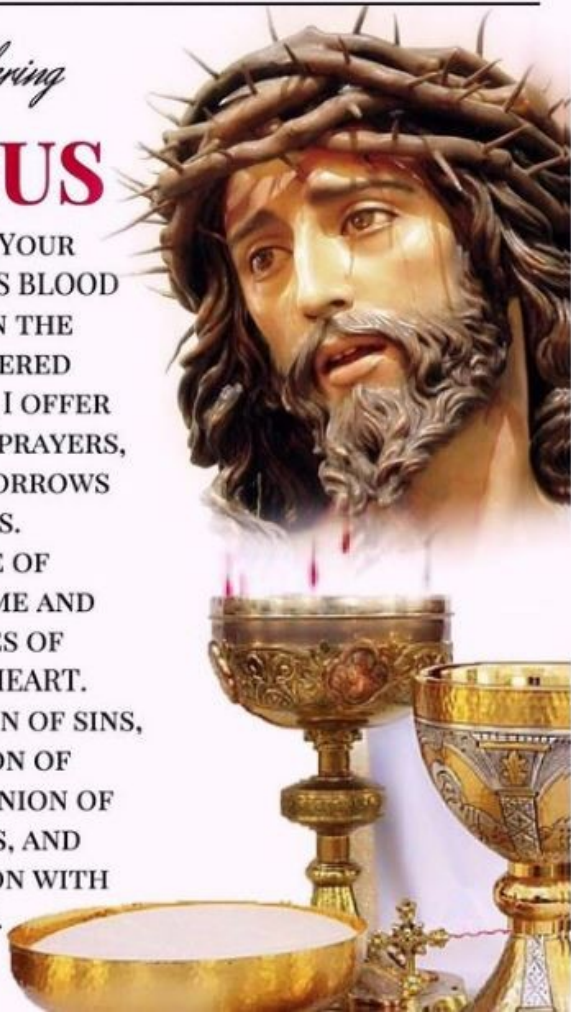

However, even though priests have a very special job, they are still people like you. They need lots of help from God to do their job well. We should pray for our priests every day!

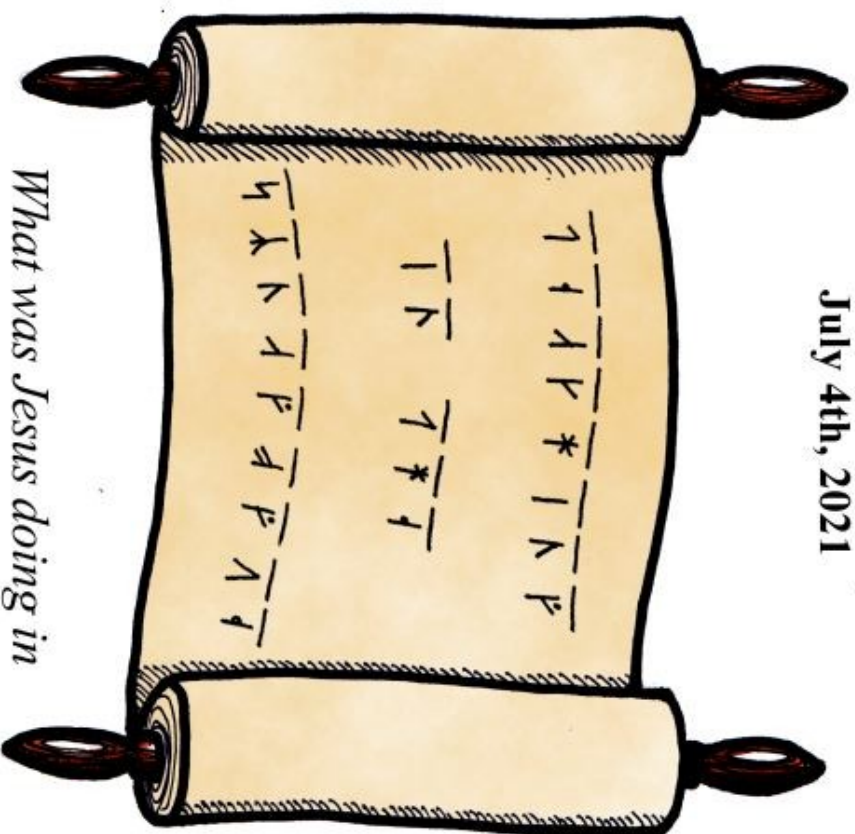
Here is a prayer you can say:
