

Stewardship Reflection Solemnity of the Most Holy **Body and Blood of Christ**

1st Reading: Exodus 24.3-8 2nd Reading: Hebrews 9.11-15 Gospel: Mark 14.12-16, 22-26

The Last Supper - You Are What You Eat

We celebrate today the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ - Corpus Christi. The Eucharist is the center of the Mass and of our entire Catholic faith. St. Padre Pio said that "it would be easier for the world to survive without the sun than to do without Holy Mass." Let us spend some time reflecting on the Eucharist so that we can echo St. Padre Pio and come to a greater understanding of the beauty of the Mass.

Let us first contemplate what took place 2000 years ago on Good Friday. Jesus' death on the cross is what won for us our salvation. It was the event that defeated Satan and opened wide the gates of Heaven so that we who seek to follow Him can enter into that eternal rest. St. Thomas Aguinas says that "the celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross." If we are able to understand just how extraordinary Jesus' crucifixion was, so too, each and every Mass opens us up to abundant grace and healing.

Moreover, the Mass allows us to receive the very body of Jesus and in doing so, become who we consume. We become another Christ in this world. How do I receive Communion well?


- 1. Be ready! Think about what is going to happen. Make sure that you don't have any big sins on your soul If you do, then go to confession first.
