Stewardship Reflection

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

1st Reading: Deuteronomy 6.2-6

2nd Reading: Hebrews 7.23-28

Gospel: Mark 12.28-34

The First Commandment

A Steward's Way of Loving

"You shall love The Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength ... You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these." Love – that is what is at the core of our Christian stewardship. In response to God's love and goodness for us, we are inspired to love Him and our neighbour.

Jesus isn't vague in his explanation on how we ought to love. Instead, he specifies in great detail that we are to love with our whole heart, soul, mind and strength. In essence, we are called to love with our entire lives. In order to love in this manner, it is essential to embrace a spirituality of stewardship. An authentic steward is called to offer the gifts of their time and talent to God and the Church.

One way in which we can love through the gift of our time is through our dedication to prayer. We are woven out of time, so what we spend our time on greatly reflects what is most important to us. As stewards, we should set aside a portion of each day that is reserved solely for prayer. In regards to our talents, we can love others by sharing these gifts with our parish community through various ministries. For example, if you feel called to the read at the Holy Mass, perhaps you can look into joining the parish Lector Ministry Team. Let us take some time to reflect on how we can better use our time and talents to love God and our neighbour with our entire lives, by serving our parish community. November: The Month of the Faithful Departed

During November, the Church calls us to commend to the Lord our departed brothers and sisters—the Souls in Purgatory—so that they might enter into the glory and joy of heaven. Prayer for the faithful departed is beautifully described here by Pope Benedict XVI:

[If] Purgatory did not exist, we should have to invent it. Why? Because few things are as immediate, as human, and as widespread—at all time and in all cultures—as prayer for one’s own departed dear ones. Praying for one’s departed loved ones is a far too immediate urge to be suppressed; it is a most beautiful manifestation of solidarity, love, and assistance, reaching beyond the barrier of death. The happiness or unhappiness of a person dear to me, who has now crossed to the other shore, depends in part on whether I remember or forget him; he does not stop needing my love.

Our parish remembers our faithful departed with a remembrance vase at each church, where you can place the names and a Mass offering for your loved ones who have passed away. The two weekday Masses on November 2nd are open to all who want to remember their beloved dead in a special way, and for those who have lost a loved one in the past year. Make an additional initiative this month to pray for the holy souls in purgatory, they need our prayers, as they too will pray for us when they reach eternal life in Heaven.

Plenary Indulgence for Feast of All Souls’ Day

Nov. 2: All Souls’ Day indulgence, “established on the occasion of the Commemoration of all the deceased faithful for those who piously visit a church or oratory and recite the ‘Our Father’ and the ‘Creed’ there. May be transferred not only to the Sunday before or after or on the day of the Solemnity of All Saints, but also to another day of the month of November, freely chosen by the individual faithful..” (See below for indulgence conditions)

Steps to Obtain a Plenary Indulgence for Holy Souls in Purgatory this November:

1) Pray at a Cemetery

The indulgence asks the faithful to “visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased, **even if only mentally.**” Some suggested prayers include the [Prayer of St. Gertrude](#) or the [Eternal Rest prayer](#).

2) Go to Confession & Receive Holy Communion

In order for one to obtain a plenary indulgence, whether it be for the poor souls or for oneself, the person **must detach oneself from all sin.** If the soul is not detached, a partial indulgence will be applied.

However, for the sick, elderly, homebound, or those who cannot go out due to Covid restrictions, they can “unite themselves spiritually to other members of the faithful.”

3) Pray for the Pope

The Church suggests that the faithful pray one ‘Our Father’ and one ‘Hail Mary’ for the Holy Father.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let the perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

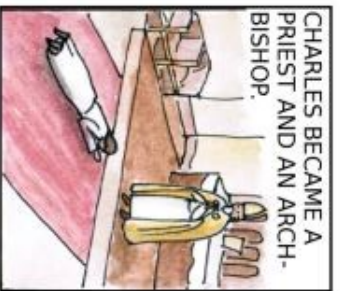

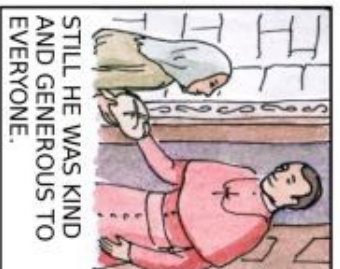
