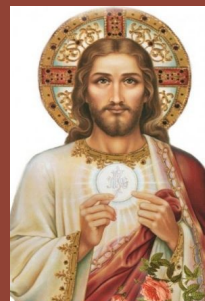

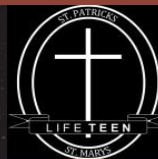

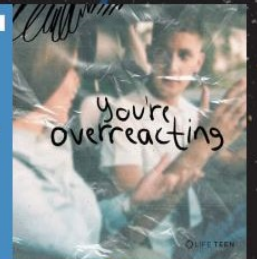

### Sharing the Love of Christ

This Sunday we hear St. Paul's famous discourse on love from his first letter to the Corinthians. God is Love. Therefore, love is at the very core of who we are as a Christian people. In order to be faithful disciples of Christ and authentic stewards, we must fully embody what it means to love. Let us take some time to reflect on why love is so important and then on how we can let love infuse every act of our stewardship. St. Paul says that even if we were to serve Christ and do many good works, if we didn't have love we would "be nothing." Love is what makes our stewardship have significance. Without love, our good works can be seen as a form of social volunteerism. However, when we truly love those whom we serve, we do a great service for them because we point them to the Love of Christ. Above all of our material needs, we all have a great need to be satisfied with a love that never fails which can only be found in Christ. That is why it is so important to serve others with love. But how can we infuse all our acts with love? The simple principle remains that we cannot give what we do not have. In order to love others with God's love, we must first be filled with that same love through our practice of prayer.

Let us take a few minutes each day to realize just how deeply Christ loves each and every one of us. We can then go out and set the world on fire with His love.

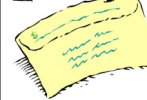

## How to Make Decisions Together - Fr. Mike Schmitz

Fr. Mike says the best way to make decisions together is to distinguish between **preferences** and **principles**. If the reason you're favoring a choice is a matter of **principle**, it is your duty to lead the other person in that decision to the truth of that **principle**. If the choice you're favoring is just a matter of **preference** though, charity suggests that you default to the preference of the beloved one involved in the decision instead. Fr. Mike uses going to church as an example. It is a matter of **principle** that we have to go to Sunday Mass and worship God the way He tells us to, so if someone tells us going to a Catholic Mass is just our **preference** we can tell them as a matter of fact it's not. However, if the issue is which church we go to for Sunday Mass, say St. Francis' Church or St. Andrew's, more often than not that is just a matter of **preference**. 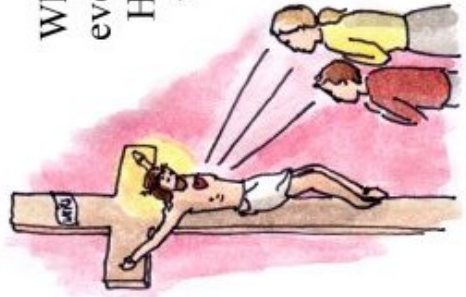

SAINT PAUL MIKI WAS A YOUNG JAPANESE MAN IN THE 1500'S. HE STUDIED IN THE JESUIT SCHOOLS AND BECAME A JESUIT.



HE BECAME AN EXCELLENT PREACHER. SOON THE EMPEROR BECAME SUSPICIOUS OF THE CHRISTIANS.



26 CHRISTIANS WERE MARCHED 600 MILES AND TORTURED ALONG THE WAY.



PAUL WAS ONE. THERE WERE TWO OTHER JESUITS AND SIX FRANCISCANS.



THERE WERE ALSO TRADESMEN AND THREE ALTAR BOYS.



ALL OF THEM WERE TIED AND CHAINED TO CROSSES ON A HILL NEAR NAGASAKI.
