

Stewardship Reflection:1st Reading: Genesis 18.20-32
2nd Reading: Colossians 2.12-14 Gospel: Luke 11.1-13
The Lord's Prayer and Perseverance in Prayer

The readings this week remind us of the importance of perseverance in prayer. The first reading tells us about how Abraham prayed to God for the sake of Sodom and Gomorrah. Abraham was able to speak to God in an intimate and sincere fashion because he had a relationship with God. Abraham was aware of the awesome power that God had, but like friends speaking to each other, Abraham was able to ask the Lord for mercy on the people.

When Jesus teaches the disciples the "Our Father," He shows us that God is not a distant God. Rather, He is close to us and cares for us with a Father's love. Like any good father, God will give to His children what they ask for, just as long as it is for the well-being and salvation of themselves and others. Do we see God as our Father? Do we go to Him with all our problems and needs? Are we persistent in prayer like Abraham was? When we see ourselves as beloved children of God and learn to rely on God for our every need, our lives become transformed.



On Sunday, July 24th, the Second World Day for Grandparents, and the Elderly will be celebrated throughout the universal Church. This Day is celebrated on the fourth Sunday of July, around the feast of St. Joachim & St. Anne, the

grandparents of Jesus. The theme chosen by the Holy Father is "In old age they will still bear fruit" (Psalm 92:15) and intends to emphasize how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift both for society and for the ecclesial communities. The Holy Father addresses this generation to remind them that those in old age have an important mission in life, called to be "artisans of the revolution of tenderness" and to "set the world free from the spectre of loneliness & the demon of war". Furthermore, the Pope invites them to rediscover this stage as "the gift of a long life".






