

<u>Baptisms</u>

Celebrated at both **St. Patrick Parish** and **St. Mary Mission.** Baptism registration forms are available at the parish office. Both parents are required to be registered parishioners for 2 months prior to Baptism and must attend <u>1 Baptism Catechism Class</u>. Baptism certificates (original or copy) are required from parents.

<u>Marriages</u>

The engaged couple should contact their parish priest at least one year in advance of the intended date of the wedding. The date will <u>not be</u> <u>confirmed</u> until after the initial interview. One of the two must be a registered parishioner of St. Patrick's Parish or St. Mary's Mission for at least one year before the initial interview.




