


When we are small there are things that we like to do, like playing with toys, that we won't like as much when we get bigger. As we get older, different things make us harry but

we get bigger. As we get older, different things make us happy, but when we get to Heaven it will be something even better that we will


God! We will realize that what makes us the very happiest is not toys or friends or a husband or wife, but God Himself!


