

Moses didn't give up, and he didn't go it alone. He got more comfortable and enlisted the help of Aaron and Hur. Look around-do you see a Moses fighting valiantly, yet growing weary? Perhaps it is your spouse, a friend or maybe your shepherd. If you see it, RESPOND!! Grab a friend and join in the battle! Not sure how you can get involved? St Paul gives us a stern charge in today's second reading: "be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient; convince, reprimand, encourage through all patience and teaching." Take Charge!!!




