**Moses Prevails**

Do you ever just want to throw in the towel? Fed up with the lack of justice that is ruminating in the world? Tired of not seeing the fruits of your persistence? Not sure if God is listening? You are not alone. Look at Moses in today's first reading. He got tired, and when he did we saw what happened—Israel began losing the battle against Amalek. Moses didn't give up, and he didn't go it alone. He got more comfortable and enlisted the help of Aaron and Hur. Look around—do you see a Moses fighting valiantly, yet growing weary? Perhaps it is your spouse, a friend or maybe your shepherd. If you see it, RESPOND!! Grab a friend and join in the battle! Not sure how you can get involved? St Paul gives us a stern charge in today's second reading: “be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient; convince, reprimand, encourage through all patience and teaching.” Take Charge!!!
