From the pastors Desk:

Most of us have to deal with a dizzy array of "oughts" and "musts" in our life which may leave us feeling guilty for falling short of others' expectations. Of course, we do fall hope-ASIOK lessly short of obeying God's commands. How can we have a pure heart that can see God? Our

heart will never be perfectly pure on this side of eternity. But Jesus has done the impossible for us. He has purified our hearts by his blood, shed on the cross, which cleanses us from all sin. A pure heart has been sprinkled clean by our baptism. A pure heart holds fast to the confession of our hope in Christ without wavering. A pure heart spurs others on to a life of love and good deeds. And a pure heart encourages others in the faith, as we see the Day approaching when we will see our Saviour face-to-face.

Communion Reflection... Jesus lived with hardship and died with suffering. On the cross, he endured agonizing physical pain and the crushing spiritual weight of all sin for all time. He was a man familiar with suffering. As human beings, we are familiar with suffering too, but not in the same way. Jesus' suffering secured our salvation. Our suffering contributed nothing toward salvation. It's the result of living in a sinful world, that includes suffering for the gospel-being despised by some for being a Christian. Difficult as this is, Peter encourages, "Yet if any of you suffer as a Christian, do not consider it a disgrace, but glorify God because you bear this name." Paul's words in Roman 8:18 lift our hearts, "I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory about to be revealed to us."
