



**Communion Reflection...**In a matter of days, Jesus would be lifted up on the cross. He would have to suffer and die before he would be lifted up in glory. But the people in the crowd didn't understand. To them the cross was a sign of desolation. They were ready for glory now. The crowds of the curious don't want to hear about sin or suffering. They want to hear about peace and prosperity for the faithful. They flock to the churches that promise a prosperous road to glory. The cross is the ultimate sign of hope. But for Jesus, the way to glory led through a minefield of temptation and torture, ending in a seemingly tragic death. However, his suffering and death were the true way to glory. Three days after being lifted up on the cross, Jesus was lifted from the grave, forty days later, he was lifted up to heavenly glory, assuring us that one day we will be lifted up to live with him in glory everlasting.

**The special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis** proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV will take place from 10 January 2026 to 10 January 2027, on the occasion of the eighth centenary of the death of Saint Francis of Assisi. St. Francis Prayer...Lord, make me an instrument of your love. Where the darkness of loneliness reigns let me bring the light of friendship. Where the darkness of bitterness reigns let me bring the light of forgiveness. Where the darkness of hurt reigns let me bring the light of healing. Where the darkness of discord reigns let me bring the light of harmony. Where the darkness of sadness reigns let me bring the light of joy. Where the darkness of doubt reigns let me bring the light of faith. Where the darkness of despair reigns let me bring the light of hope. And where the darkness of hatred reigns let me bring the light of love.

Father of mercy, bring us face to face with our own weakness when we are tempted to judge others. May we find peace and life in simply stepping back and allowing you to be the merciful Judge of us all. Amen.

Have you or a loved one endured the pain and anguish of abandonment, being forsaken by someone who was loved and trusted? The mystery of the cross is shrouded in Jesus' abandonment for those three dreaded hours.

He was forsaken not just by his closest friends, but even by his heavenly Father. That sounds unthinkable. But that's how God chose to share with us and all humanity the heart of his divine love and saving grace. It was as if the Father drew a curtain between heaven and earth, so when Jesus cried out in total weakness and powerlessness, "My God my God, why have you forsaken me?" there was no answer. Heaven was silent. The good news is that because Jesus endured the hell of separation from the Father, we never have to fear being forsaken by God. We can count on him to be with us always, through our times of darkness and distress, embracing us with a compassion that extinguishes the darkness.



I can still remember being in the chapel when it came time for Holy Communion. While we were singing the communion hymn, the organist stopped playing. There was no carpeting on the floor, so the sound of worshipers moving down the aisle seemed to echo off the walls and high ceiling. That memory still stands out in my mind today as a reminder that those who came to partake of Jesus' body and blood came, as if to say, "I share in his death." In that moment, I felt as if I was truly part of Jesus' body, the Church. But isn't that what the self-giving love of Jesus comes to do?
