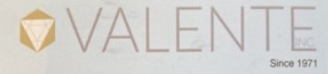

Rev. Mr. Rafał Michał Bartosiński, 41, I grew up in Poland. The very important moment of my life was the death of Pope John Paul II. It was then that I felt that the Lord was calling me to enter the seminary, though it took him a few years before I decided to go. Meantime, I studied theology at the University of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński and worked. In 2009, I joined a community of the Neocatechumenal Way. It was in this community that in 2011, I made the decision to enter the Seminary. I was sent to the Redemptoris Mater Missionary Seminary of Toronto where I had one year of missionary experience in Israel and was sent to Blessed Sacrament Parish for my internship year. I am now finishing theological studies at Saint Augustine's. I was ordained on June 27<sup>th</sup> 2020 by Cardinal Thomas Collins and worked as an associate Pastor at St. John Chrysostom Parish in Newmarket from 2020-2023, Guardian Angels Parish in Orillia from 2023-2025 and currently St. Joseph Parish in Mississauga.

It would demand feeding, watering, grooming, walking and spending plenty of time playing with the dog. Of course, he would have to give her lots of love. After explaining the job description, they asked what the job would be worth to him. The little boy replied, “I’ll give you ten bucks.” Little Mike saw it as a privilege to care for the dog. Too often we see loving God and loving our neighbour as a chore. We tolerate it at best. Like Mike, we should view it as a privilege when we can serve and love our neighbour. When we love our neighbour, we are loving God.

**Communion Reflection...** Trying to control her dry hair, a woman treated her scalp with olive oil before washing it. Worried that the oil might leave an odour, she diligently washed her hair several times. That night when she went to bed, she leaned over to her husband and asked, “Do I smell like olive oil?” “No,” he said, sniffing her. “Do I smell like Popeye?” Sin has a kind of stench. We all have it. Some just don’t acknowledge it. We spend more time comparing ourselves to others. We rationalize our goodness at times by putting others down in our minds: “At least I am not like so-and-so.” We are to focus on ourselves—recognizing our sinfulness, yet not giving in to discouragement. May we sincerely offer the prayer: “O God, be merciful to me a sinner.” That is a prayer that God always hears.
