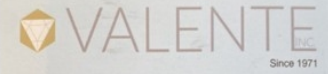

It was then that I felt that the Lord was calling me to enter the seminary, though it took him a few years before I decided to go. Meantime, I studied theology at the University of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński and worked. In 2009, I joined a community of the Neocatechumenal Way. It was in this community in 2011, I made the decision to enter the Seminary. I was sent to the Redemptoris Mater Missionary Seminary of Toronto where I had one year of missionary experience in Israel and was sent to Blessed Sacrament Parish for my internship year. I am now finishing theological studies at Saint Augustine's. I was ordained on June 27th 2020 by Cardinal Thomas Collins and worked as an associate Pastor at St. John Chrysostom Parish in Newmarket from 2020-2023, Guardian Angels Parish in Orillia from 2023-2025 and currently St. Joseph Parish in Mississauga. 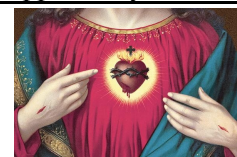
What makes a DAD
